

She has participated on different academic assignments in the Documentary Film Festival in Istanbul, Macedonia Festival, Zubroffka Festival in Poland and different other festivals in home and abroad. She is a regular contributor in various academic journals, web magazines, national and international film and academic journals. She teaches Political Science in a College in Kolkata and is doing her PhD thesis on cinema.

Subrata Sen

Subrata Sen is a film director, screenwriter, novelist and producer. He made his first feature film Ek Je Achhe Kanya in 2001 introducing Konkona Sen Sharma. The film won the Gollapudi Srinivas National Award. He made his second feature film as Swapner Feriwala in 2002. Both of his first two films were there in the line-up of the Karlovy Vary Film Festival. His third feature film Nil Nirjane made in 2003 was the first digital film of India. Then he made Hotath Neerar Jonnyo (2005) and Bibar (2006). Bibar won the best actor and best actress awards at the Osian Cinefan Film Festival New Delhi. His next film Koyekti Meyer Golpo (2012) was there in the competition section of Madrid International Film Festival. His documentary Kali (2018) is acclaimed highly. He has four published Bengali novels to his credit.
