As an actor his performance in many films like *Shubho Mahurat* (2003), *Rupkatha Noy* (2013), *Manojder Adbhut Bari* (2018) and others are highly appreciated.

She is a regular contributor in various academic journals, web magazines, national and international film and academic journals. She teaches Political Science in a College in Kolkata and is doing her PhD thesis on cinema.

Subrata Sen

Subrata Sen is a film director, screenwriter, novelist and producer. He made his first feature film *Ek Je Achhe Kanya* in 2001 introducing Konkona Sen Sharma. The film won the Gollapudi Srinivas National Award. He made his second feature film as *Swapner Feriwala* in 2002. Both of his first two films were there in the line-up of the Karlovy Vary Film Festival. His third feature film *Nil Nirjane* made in 2003 was the first digital film of India. Then he made *Hotath Neerar Jonnyo* (2005) and *Bibar* (2006). *Bibar* won the best actor and best actress awards at the Osian Cinefan Film Festival New Delhi. His next film *Koyekti Meyer Golpo* (2012) was there in the competition section of Madrid International Film Festival. His documentary *Kali* (2018) is acclaimed highly. He has four published Bengali novels to his credit.
